Day 1-Sunday, June 11: Trans-Atlantic Flight. Depart Raleigh, NC for Tel Aviv.

Day 2- Monday, June 12: From Tel Aviv to Ashkelon. Arrive in Ben Gurion International Airport. Enjoy lunch in bustling Tel Aviv. Head south to Ashkelon, an ancient Philistine stronghold and modern city with breathtaking views of the Mediterranean. Enjoy the beach and a swim in the ocean. Overnight in Ashkelon at the Leonardo Hotel.

Day 3- Tuesday, June 13: The Southern Desert. Begin by scouting out the land in the Wilderness of Tzin. Head to Kibbutz Revivim, the earliest Zionist outpost in the Negev. Experience the simple beauty of the Negev, cross the desert and spend the evening floating in the Dead Sea. Enjoy spa amenities (optional, additional fees) at the Dead Sea resort. Overnight at the Dead Sea at the Prima Oasis.

Day 4- Wednesday, June 14: Masada and Ein Gedi. Visit Masada, Herod's Fortress and last point of Jewish resistance against the Romans. Move on to Ein Gedi, site of David's hiding places. Ascend to Jerusalem. View the Old City from Mount Scopus, locale of Hebrew University. Visit the Western Wall plaza. Overnight in Jerusalem at the Prima Kings Hotel.

Day 5- Thursday, June 15: The Old City of Jerusalem. Visit the Garden of Gethsemane. Experience the City of David, including Hezekiah's Tunnel, as well as the Jewish Quarter in the Old City. Take in the Burnt House, Cardo, Herodian Ruins, Hurva Synagogue, and Alone on the Wall Museum. Overnight in Jerusalem at the Prima Kings Hotel.

Day 6- Friday, June 16: The New City of Jerusalem. View the Knesset Building (seat of the Israeli Parliament). Visit Second Temple Period Model, and Yad VaShem Holocaust Memorial Museum. Enter the Garden Tomb in East Jerusalem (pre-1967 Jordan) to view an ancient tomb akin to the one in which Yeshua was placed. Overnight in Jerusalem at the Prima Kings Hotel.

Day 7- Saturday, June 17: Shabbat in Jerusalem. Celebrate Shabbat. Afternoon free to return to the Western Wall and Jewish Quarter, enjoy the quiet streets of Jerusalem, and/or visit Chosen People Ministries' Israel Center. Evening free to visit Ben Yehuda Street for shopping and night life. Overnight in Jerusalem at the Prima Kings Hotel.

Day 8- Sunday, June 18: Ancient Jerusalem. Participate in an archaeological dig at Emek Zurim. Visit the Southern Steps of the Temple, the Rabbis' Tunnel (with foundation stones of the Temple dating back to ancient times), the Friends of Zion Museum, and Machaneh Yehudah Market. Overnight in Jerusalem at the Prima Kings Hotel.

Day 9- Monday, June 19: The North and the Sea of Galilee. Immersion in the Jordan River. Explore the well-preserved Roman city of Beit She'an. Possible visit to Nazareth Bible College for fellowship with Arab brothers and sisters in Messiah. Overnight in Tiberius at Ma'agan Eden Kibbutz.

Day 10- Tuesday, June 20: In and Around the Galilee. Visit the ancient synagogue in Magdala. Head to Capernaum to see the synagogue and traditional site of the home of Shimon Kefa (Peter). Move to the Second Temple Period synagogue of Gamla. Visit the Igal Alon Museum to view the famous Galilean boat dating to the first-century CE. Experience an exclusive visit to an IDF unit. Swim in the Sea of Galilee. Overnight in Tiberius at Ma'agan Eden Kibbutz.

Day 11- Wednesday, June 21: The Galilee and Golan Heights. Stop in at Tamar Plus, a kibbutz that produces date products. Shop for unique products in the Kibbutz store. Visit Baniyas/Caesarea Phillipi, site of Kefa's proclamation of Yeshua's messiahship. Head farther north to the Golan Heights to visit Mt Bental and pray overlooking the Israel-Syrian border. Overnight in Tiberius at Ma'agan Eden Kibbutz.

Day 12- Thursday, June 22: – Caesarea and Tel Aviv. Walk the ruins of Caesarea, city of Cornelius the centurion. Take advantage of some final shopping at Diezengoff, in the bustling center of Tel Aviv. Overnight at the Metropolitan Hotel in Tel Aviv.

Day 13- Friday, June 23: Return Flight to Raleigh. Depart Ben Gurion Airport and arrive home with many memories, souvenirs, pictures, and a deeper connection with HaShem, Messiah, one another, and Eretz Yisrael!
